SPF

Our SPF lumber is a combination of three Western Canadian softwood species: spruce, pine and fir. This unique species-mix offers high-grade lumber with small, tight knots resulting in extremely high fibre strength able to withstand the toughest inclement weather. Even with its superior strength, SPF lumber remains lightweight and very easy to work with.

DOUGLAS FIR/LARCH

Douglas fir/larch lumber boasts tight, straight grain, light brown in colour with a hint of red. Strong and easily adaptable, this lumber is one of the best building materials available on the market today. Valued for its dimensional stability and high specific gravity, this species variety offers superior fastener holding, along with a high strength to weight ratio. Douglas fir/larch has the highest Modulus of Elasticity (MOE) value of all North American tree species.

HEMLOCK/FIR

Hem-fir is a species combination of Western Hemlock and true firs. Possessing a lower density, hemlock/fir is easily pressure-treated with preservatives, and is available in structural, appearance and remanufacturing grades.

WESTERN RED CEDAR

Western Red Cedar is a soft, straight-grained species that is extremely resistant to decay and insect damage. It is preferred for exterior sidings, fences, decks and other outdoor applications.


